Cancellations / Substitutions

Cancellations made before 27th March 2017 will be charged at 50% of the invoice total. Cancellations made between this date and 6th April 2017 will be charged at 75% of the invoice total. Cancellations made after this date will be charged the full invoice total.

Bookings received less than two weeks before the conference date (13th April 2017) can only be paid by credit card. Cancellations and substitutions must be made in writing.
